SOLEMNITY OF THE EPIPHANY OF THE LORD

Epiphany is celebrated either on January 6 or, according to the decision of the episcopal conference, on the Sunday between January 2 and January 8. The young Messiah is revealed as the light of the nations. Yet, as the antiphon for the Magnificat at Second Vespers reminds us, three mysteries are encompassed in this solemnity: the adoration of the Christ Child by the Magi, the Baptism of Christ and the wedding feast at Cana. Extra candles and/or lamps may be placed around the sanctuary and in other parts of the church to honor Christ revealed as the Light of the Gentiles (Ceremonial of Bishops). It is customary to replace the images of the shepherds at the crib with the three Magi and their gifts. —Ceremonies of the Liturgical Year, Msgr. Peter J. Elliott, Ignatius Press.

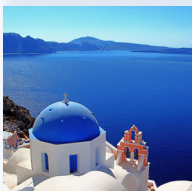

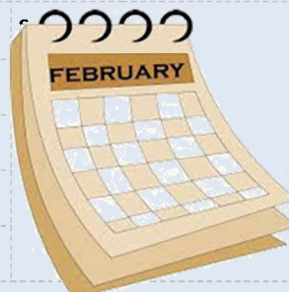

8 de enero de 2023 • La Epifanía del Señor

DIFUNDIR LA BUENA NOTICIA

La Epifanía es un día en el que las costumbres populares eclipsan la mayor parte de las veces la exactitud bíblica. El Evangelio de Mateo nunca se refiere a los reyes que vinieron a ver a Cristo, ni a su número (sólo se enumeran los regalos), ni a sus nombres. Mateo sólo nos dice que algunos “magos” vinieron con oro, incienso y mirra. Magos se refería a los miembros de la clase sacerdotal persa; más tarde tuvo la connotación de magos y astrólogos. Los magos de Mateo informan de que han visto salir una estrella; su luz era visible para ellos más allá de las fronteras de Israel, un símbolo temprano y significativo de Jesús, la Luz del Mundo. Al final del Evangelio de Mateo (capítulo 28), los seguidores de Jesús lo adoran, un acto predicho en las acciones de los Magos de hoy. A los once se les dice que hagan discípulos de “todas las naciones”, naciones simbolizadas por los Magos. Hoy escuchamos nuestra propia misión: adorar a Jesucristo y difundir su Buena Noticia por todas partes, todos los días.

ESTRELLA DE LA MARAVILLA

En nuestro día a día, podemos experimentar epifanías: nuevas percepciones, visiones inesperadas, cambios de rumbo repentinos. En el año litúrgico, la Epifanía celebra la aparición de una estrella en los cielos, una estrella extraordinaria que los Magos siguieron hasta Jesús, María y José. No son tan diferentes, nuestras epifanías cotidianas y la Epifanía que se celebra hoy. La llegada de los Reyes Magos cambió sin duda la percepción del mundo de María y José, del mismo modo que un bebé indefenso y diminuto probablemente alteró la percepción de los Reyes Magos sobre lo que revelaría una estrella en el cielo. La historia de los Reyes Magos -y la de Jesús, María y José- está llena de cambios de rumbo inesperados, ya que el plan de Dios sigue variando cuando encuentra personas que cooperan con él y otras que intentan frustrarlo. Una profunda y larga reflexión sobre este día que llamamos Epifanía descubrirá numerosas epifanías.

ESTRELLA DEL AMOR

Como todo el tiempo de Navidad, la Epifanía celebra el amor eterno e infinito de Dios. De manera especial, este día muestra cómo el amor de Dios es verdaderamente inclusivo. Los magos no eran judíos, no formaban parte del Pueblo Elegido que esperaba que el Mesías viniera a salvarlos sólo a ellos. Al principio de su Evangelio, Mateo nos dice que el amor de Dios no estará limitado por nuestras presunciones o fronteras humanas. Seguimos luchando con el hecho de que Dios nos epifaniza constantemente para que crezcamos más allá de los límites de nuestra experiencia o expectativas, para que vayamos más allá de los límites del mundo que nos rodea. Recemos para que se nos concedan epifanías que nos ayuden a encontrar la gracia donde no creíamos que existiera, que nos ayuden a comprender que el amor de Dios se muestra más a menudo por quien está incluido, no por quien está excluido. Que abramos nuestros ojos y corazones para saber que la luz de Cristo brilla en todas partes.

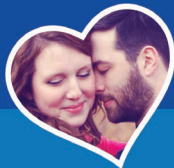

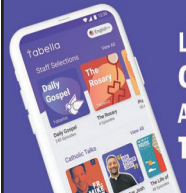

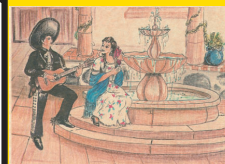
