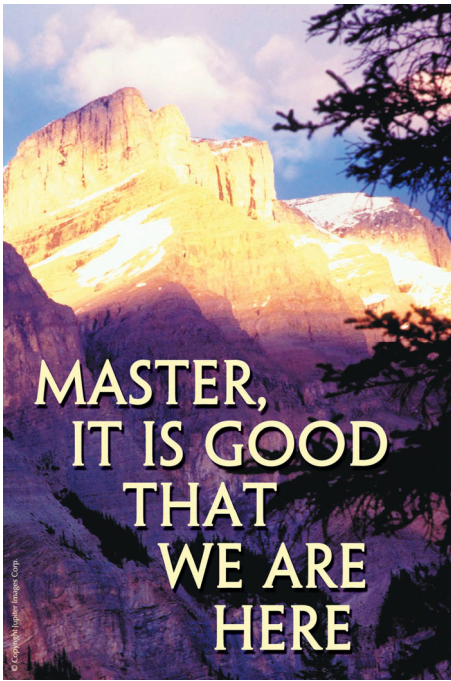

SECOND SUNDAY OF LENT

OF YOU MY HEART HAS SPOKEN: SEEK HIS FACE. IT IS YOUR FACE, O LORD, THAT I SEEK; HIDE NOT YOUR FACE FROM ME.

PSALM 27:8-9

Abrams's faith is sealed with a covenant initiated by God (1), our light and our salvation (Ps). The transfiguration of Jesus (3) prefigures the transformation in glory to which we are called by our sharing in the paschal mystery—the dying and rising of Jesus (2).

FIRST READING—GENESIS 15:5-12

The Lord made a covenant with his faithful servant, Abram, saying, "To your descendants I give this land."

PSALM—PSALM 27

The Lord is my light and my salvation.

SECOND READING—PHILIPPIANS 3:17

We await the Lord Jesus, who will change us to conform with his glorified body.

GOSPEL—LUKE 9:28b-36

Peter, James, and John witness the transfiguration of Jesus on the mountain.

SECOND SUNDAY OF LENT

The story of the Transfiguration of Jesus in the Luke's Gospel this week is similar to the ones in Matthew and Mark. One difference I noticed in Luke's version is that Jesus does not tell the three disciples to keep it secret. It seems they decided on their own not to tell anyone.

One reason may be what they heard. While Matthew and Mark just say that Jesus spoke with Moses and Elijah, Luke is more specific: They "spoke of his exodus that he was going to accomplish in Jerusalem" (9:31). Jesus had just said that he would suffer, die, and be raised from the dead in Luke 9:22. They probably hoped he was just telling them the worst that could happen, not what really would happen. So hearing it from Moses and Elijah as well as from Jesus was too much for them.

This is where we come in. The apostles were afraid to face the coming passion and death of Jesus. I think we are like them in that we suffer more in anticipating what would hurt us than we do going through it. That is where faith can help. In faith, we hear Jesus tell us not to fear, as he often told his disciples. We know that Jesus suffered on the cross, so he knows what suffering is. And faith tells us that he is with us even when the suffering is the result of our own sins. After all, he himself suffered because of our sins. So have faith!

Tyler named Luz Morlet as our Synod Parish Coordinator and she organized three zoom meetings with church leadership, two in English, one in Spanish. Each ministry leader had “Listening Sessions” with their groups in various ways, some in person, some by zoom, some by email. Participants were asked to pray the Synod prayer and then answer the four questions given to us by the Diocese. She also sent a link to the Diocesan Synod Form through our Flocknote system. Our parish staff was also invited to send their responses to the Diocesan Synod Google Form.</p> |
| TOP THREE REVEALING DISCOVERIES: |
| <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. There are many activities in our church but not all feel welcome. 2. Parishioners are grateful for Perpetual Adoration. 3. We need to do a better job in bringing the youth to the Church. |
| COMMONALITIES: |
| <p>The most common observations from the consultations were:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. How does journeying together happen in our local church? Through the Mass, the Sacraments, Bible studies, prayer groups, Liturgical Ministries, Adoration, RCIA, Faith Formation for adults and children and various events. 2. What has been your experience of how the church has journeyed with you? The availability of Perpetual Adoration, Catholic school, individuals helping, the priest asking parishioners to participate, communication through Flocknote, bulletin (online and printed), letters, pilgrimages with the Pastor, through sacramental preparation and the receiving of the Sacraments. Personal experiences like divorce support or family deaths. Fr. Tyler’s personal touch has been very important for parishioners. 3. What steps does the Holy Spirit invite us to take in order to grow in our journeying together? To put God first, to pray, to believe, to receive Holy Communion, to spend time with Jesus in Adoration, to invite those who have fallen away from the Church, to do service, to be more like Christ, to participate in different ministries, to see the face of God in our neighbors, to not have any divisions amongst groups. 4. As Bishop Taylor and our Church listens, what else is important for them to hear? We need to follow Jesus and His teachings. We need to proclaim the truth as written in the Scripture and in the teachings of the Church. Catholic Doctrine should not be changed or be watered down out of fear of upsetting individualism, liberalism, gender bending, attacks on life, etc. We shouldn’t stray from our Catholic faith core teachings in order not to hurt someone’s feelings. Homilies with more ties to the catechism, also printed homilies for those who are hard of hearing. Invite people to return to church after pandemic. Support Catholic High School. There are parishioners that don’t believe in mandated vaccinations, they need to be respected. The decision to ban the Traditional Mass was not handled in a Christian fashion. We need more Catholic outreach, including young Catholics involved in community work. The church leaders have done an excellent job in communicating throughout the pandemic. In bringing people to the Catholic Church, we have so much, but we don’t do a good job inviting people to groups, ministries, Bible studies, etc. More community gatherings outside of Mass. More community gathering for liturgical events, such as processions, vigils, etc. Keep priest in churches more than 6 years. |
