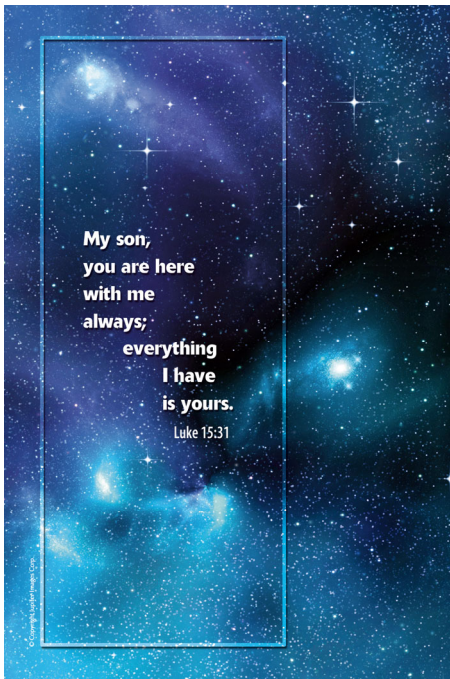

LOST AND FOUND

The parable of the father and his sons is one of the most familiar of all of Jesus' stories. The father in the parable is lavish in forgiveness and revels in the return of his young son, who was lost and now is found. The Israelites spent many years lost in the desert, seeking the land of milk and honey, yet often failing to seek the God who delivered and fed them. We are sometimes lost as well. We lose sight of the Lord and the Lord's ways. God never loses sight of us, however. God waits, ready for us to come to our senses, ready to welcome us back with open arms.

FOURTH SUNDAY OF LENT

REJOICE, JERUSALEM, AND ALL WHO LOVE HER. BE JOYFUL, ALL WHO WERE IN MOURNING; EXULT AND BE SATISFIED AT HER CONSOLING BREAD.

PSALM 43:1-2

Having arrived in the promised land, the Hebrews celebrated their deliverance from affliction and distress (Ps) in the Passover (1). Christ, our Passover, has entrusted to us the message of reconciliation (2): let us forgive one another and celebrate the unconditional and abundant love of God our Father (3).

FIRST READING—JOSHUA 5:9a, 10-12

God's people enter the promised land, observe the Passover, and eat of the produce of the land.

PSALM—PSALM 34

Taste and see the goodness of the Lord.

SECOND READING—2 CORINTHIANS 5:17-21

We are now ambassadors for Christ.

GOSPEL—LUKE 15:1-3, 11-12

We must rejoice when our brother who was dead in sin repents and comes back to life.

FOURTH SUNDAY OF LENT

The book of Joshua tells of the Israelites coming into the Promised Land, where they no longer needed to be fed with manna as in the desert. They had been wandering much longer than expected because of their unfaithfulness. But now they are forgiven, and so celebrate the Passover with food from the land. Then we hear the Gospel parable about another feast. This one is also a celebration of forgiveness, for the prodigal son has returned to his father, and the father's forgiveness shows us how willing God is to forgive us. That's where we end the parable, right?

Wrong. The parable continues with the older son's complaint about a feast for his brother. That son cannot forgive his brother and is angry at the father for welcoming the prodigal back. This is where we come in. Most of us have no trouble asking God's forgiveness. But we may have trouble forgiving others. We are so used to thinking in terms of justice that we are not satisfied with forgiveness. When I have been hurt, I feel like hitting back.

So we have to ask ourselves whose idea of justice we live by. Is it the human expectation of an eye for an eye? Or is it God's justice, which is mercy and forgiveness? When someone cuts you off in traffic, do you feel like firing the photon torpedoes, or offering forgiveness? The Golden Rule could be "Forgive others as you would be forgiven." Jesus gave his life for the sins of the world. Do we have the right to ask for more?

“Honoring Our Past, Building Our Future” Progress Update

Design Work Progress

The schematic design phase is continuing with our construction team (Michael G. Imber Architects, Core Architects, Nabholz Construction, civil and structural engineers, and representatives from our St. Joseph Design Subcommittee). At a recent meeting, the architects presented the 30% review of the Schematic Design (SD) for our Church. The overall purpose of the 30% review is to define the major elements of the project’s design and refine the project’s scope, schedule and budget. We reviewed the basic architectural floor plan and elevations, asked questions, and gave feedback. Overall, the 30% design phase is the foundation upon which design of our new church will sit. Taking the time to analyze the drawings and give feedback will pay off as the design work continues.

Our 50% SD review will be towards the end of April. These reviews will keep us on track for better pricing to meet our budget, while confirming that the submitted plans and specifications will meet our objectives of the project without significant changes.

Other Subcommittee News

Three of our subcommittees will meet at the end of this month.

Liturgical Arts and Interiors Subcommittee will develop guidelines and criteria to ensure that art work in our new church will complement the classical design of our new church and inspire us to raise our minds and hearts to God.

Landscaping and Grounds Subcommittee will review the City of Fayetteville’s Landscape Requirements Ordinance and begin to plan a beautiful and spiritual space around our new church.
