



DIFFICULTY, SURVIVAL, AND GLORY

In Revelation, John the Evangelist tells us what we can expect as followers of the risen Jesus: distress, endurance, and a kingdom. Although we are only eight days into our fifty-day Easter feasting, we cannot ignore the distress weighing down our daily lives. Jesus' resurrection does not erase individual suffering, but his glorious triumph over death cultivates endurance in our hearts. We remember that Jesus did not spare himself, and we ask for the strength to endure as he did. Imitating Christ helps us grow as members of God's royal family.

As beloved citizens of the Kingdom of God, we recognize our kinship with all people. Peter demonstrates his care for others as he heals multitudes of broken, suffering people. In the Gospel, Thomas accepts his own spiritual healing when Jesus helps him to believe. In times of difficulty, survival, and glory, we borrow Thomas' declaration of faith: "My Lord and my God!"

4 ESDRAS 2:36-37

As Thomas believed because he saw the risen Jesus (3), so too were many brought to faith through the various signs and wonders wrought by the apostles (1). They proclaimed as Lord "the stone rejected by the builders" (Ps), "the First and the Last of the One who lives" (2).

FIRST READING—ACTS 5:12-16

The apostles perform many signs and wonders among the people.
Many are added to their numbers.

PSALM—PSALM 118

Give thanks to the Lord for he is good,
his love is everlasting.

SECOND READING—REVELATION 1:9-11a, 12-13, 17-19

John, caught up in the spirit, envisions the glorified Lord,
the first and the last, the one who lives.

GOSPEL—JOHN 20:19-31

The risen Christ comes to his disciples with peace and the Spirit.
The absent Thomas doubts.

GOD'S JUSTICE

In today's Gospel we hear Jesus say three times, "Peace be with you." This was a common greeting, but the disciples were hiding in fear so they needed reassurance. Jesus gives them that reassurance in three ways: his resurrection, forgiveness of sins, and a blessing for future disciples.

The disciples had seen Jesus crucified and were afraid any of his followers would be treated the same way. So when Jesus appeared to them, he showed them his wounds and let them touch him. He wanted to show them that he was not a ghost; he had risen from death and death has no more power over him. They can now take courage because they will share in the Resurrection themselves. Breathing on them, he bestows the Holy Spirit, source of our courage.

That leads to the second reassurance, forgiveness of sins. Jesus died to take away our sins; now he shares that with his disciples. Anyone troubled by guilt can be forgiven. The disciples themselves probably felt that need, since they had deserted Jesus and one even denied knowing him. He now sends his apostles with the mission to free others from sin. We too can forgive others (and ourselves) knowing that God has forgiven them and us.

Finally, the story of Thomas and his doubts about Jesus' resurrection gives us some hope. Jesus blesses those who "have not seen and have believed" (John 20:29). We usually think the apostles were "more" blessed for having seen and heard Jesus. But Jesus reverses that expectation; we are blessed, even two thousand years after the Resurrection.

Our History, Our Future—Our Altar *One item that has not been sponsored yet is our altar.*

In 1968, our altar made of Bianco Carrara marble arrived from Italy and was installed in the then newly-built church on the corner of Lafayette and Walnut streets. When we moved from our Lafayette Street location to Starr Drive, our altar moved with us to its temporary home in our current Chapel Center. One more move is in our altar's future. When our new church is finished, its journey to its permanent home will be complete.

Other rededication items still available are our tabernacle, altar candles, sancto light, and processional cross. Additional memorial items not yet sponsored include the sound system, porte-cochere (entrance covering), pews and kneelers, holy water fonts, nave chandelier lights, and disabled parking spaces.



PRIMARY DIMENSIONS

We are currently in Year C of the three-year Lectionary cycle. For the Second Sunday of Easter, in all three years, the first reading is from the Acts of the Apostles. Year A (from Acts 2) tells of the new Christian community's dedication to prayer. Year B (from Acts 4) tells of their sharing of goods and deep bonds of trust in each other. Today we hear in Acts 5 of the early Church's ministry of healing to the community, performed by Peter and the apostles.

These represent three of the primary dimensions of those first Christian communities: prayer in relationship to God; sharing in relationship to each other; and service in relationship to the world around them. We are reminded that all three are fundamental to our identity as Church. We fail to live fully as Church when we neglect any of these relationships. We are called to encourage their full flowering in our own parish's life.


