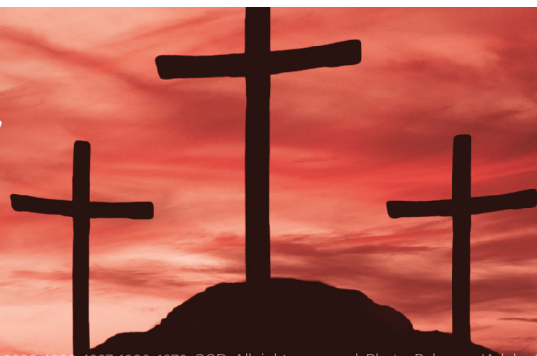

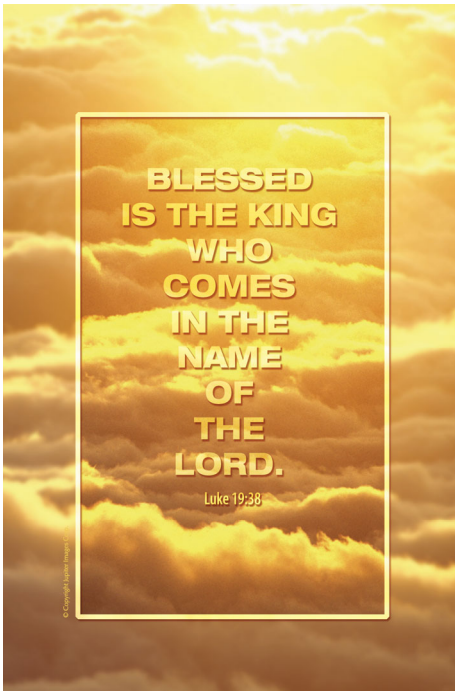

Jesus, humbling himself out of love for us (2), did not shield his face from buffets and spitting (1), but offered his life on the cross (3). He relied on his Father's love (Ps).

GOD'S JUSTICE

In the long form of the Passion from Luke's Gospel, Jesus refers to himself as "the one who serves" (Luke 22:27). This reminds me of today's second reading from Paul's letter to the Philippians. He says that Christ "emptied himself, taking the form of a slave" (Philippians 2:7). Jesus is not just being humble here. He gives us an example of how far God will go in loving humanity.

I suspect the apostles were confused when Jesus talked this way. Yet he tells them to be like a servant—expect little reward for what you do for others. Now the apostles might have thought, "Sure, I can do that. I'll preach about the Kingdom of God for free. Then I'll really look important and holy." So Jesus reminds them that the world looks at the person being served as more important than the servant. But he is one who serves. and if the apostles are to be leaders of the church they will need to be servants, too. Why? Because that is how God comes to the people.

In the Passion according to Luke, Jesus heals one of the men sent to arrest him. Barabbas, a murderer, is set free so Jesus can be crucified. As he is led to the cross, he consoles the women who weep for him. And even on the cross, he is the suffering servant who asks the Father to forgive those who are killing him.

With the example of service that Jesus shows toward those who put him to death, can we at least be "one who serves" those around us? Can we at least forgive those who hurt us—maybe even pray for our leaders, especially the ones with whom we disagree.

“Honoring Our Past, Building Our Future” Progress Update

Design Work Progress

The schematic design phase is continuing with our construction team (Michael G. Imber Architects, Core Architects, Nabholz Construction, civil and structural engineers, and representatives from our St. Joseph Design Subcommittee). At a recent meeting, the architects presented the 30% review of the Schematic Design (SD) for our Church. The overall purpose of the 30% review is to define the major elements of the project's design and refine the project's scope, schedule and budget. We reviewed the basic architectural floor plan and elevations, asked questions, and gave feedback. Overall, the 30% design phase is the foundation upon which design of our new church will sit. Taking the time to analyze the drawings and give feedback will pay off as the design work continues.

Our 50% SD review will be towards the end of April. These reviews will keep us on track for better pricing to meet our budget, while confirming that the submitted plans and specifications will meet our objectives of the project without significant changes.

Other Subcommittee News

Three of our subcommittees will meet at the end of this month.

Liturgical Arts and Interiors Subcommittee will develop guidelines and criteria to ensure that art work in our new church will complement the classical design of our new church and inspire us to raise our minds and hearts to God.

Landscaping and Grounds Subcommittee will review the City of Fayetteville's Landscape Requirements Ordinance and begin to plan a beautiful and spiritual space around our new church.

PALM SUNDAY OF THE LORD'S PASSION

Do You Know the Story?

We might assume that we know the scriptures and tend to tune out something as difficult to comprehend as the Passion of Christ. What we often end up doing is taking all four of the Gospels and sort of mixing the accounts into one story. The theologian Gerhard Lohfink called this "making Gospel Soup." Today's Passion is from the Gospel of Luke, and there are some elements that are very different from Matthew and Mark (the other synoptic Gospels read in Lectionary years A and B), and John's Gospel text which is always proclaimed on Good Friday. Let's look at the elements that are specific to Luke as we break the Passion into five sections.

The Lukan Passion

Lord's Supper (22:14-38) Luke portrays Jesus as fiery and working for justice, both in his passion and in his ministry. The Passover feast is a very special time for the disciples, and while they are being commissioned, it is clear that they do not understand yet how they will carry on; Jesus warns them to protect them from evil.

Mount of Olives (22:39-53) Luke's Jesus doesn't seem as desolate as in other accounts about his imminent death, and goes to pray in regular fashion. He calls out his betrayer by name, hinting at foreshadowing of knowledge.

Peter's Denial - Sanhedrin (22:54-71) One can see the special care Jesus takes for Peter, and the scene takes place in the courtyard where Jesus was earlier abused as prophet.

Trials before Pilate and Herod (23:1-25) In this account Pilate and Herod both proclaim Jesus to be innocent, and this heals a "riff" between them. Jesus is good even to those who maltreat him.

Crucifixion, Death, and Burial (23:26-56) There are no soldiers; it is the chief priests who take Jesus to Pilate. Jesus' words on the Cross are kind: "Father forgive them." In Mark's Gospel both criminals mocked Jesus, but here one of them begs forgiveness, and Jesus grants him salvation. Jesus' last words show a sign of trust: "Father, into your hands . . ." May we also place our trust in God as we enter into Holy Week.

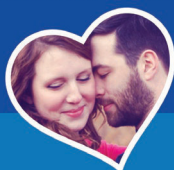

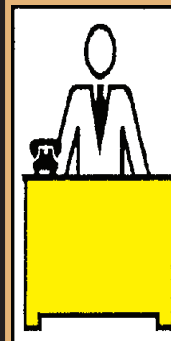

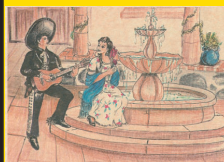
