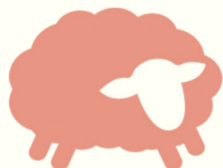

**MASS COUNT**

Every year, Catholic parishes in Arkansas report October attendance numbers to the diocese. In October 2022, St. Joseph had an average Mass attendance of 1,535 per weekend. That number is up from 1,378 in 2021 but down from 1,697 in 2019 (the last pre-Covidic year). Overall, attendance in October 2022 was 90% of our October 2019 attendance. The Sunday 5 pm Mass was the only weekend Mass with higher attendance in 2022 than in 2019. The chart below shows the numbers from 2018 until now.

## THE TRUE KINGSHIP OF JESUS CHRIST

What kind of King is Jesus? How do you envision him? Remembering that they were promised a king from the line of David, the Israelites hoped for a Messiah who would set their political problems aright and bring about a worldly kingdom of Judaic power. Even Psalm 122 seems to describe this type of ruler. Luke's Gospel today shreds that image after the whip of the Roman soldiers tore at Jesus' flesh. Still, the Romans flaunted the traditional notion with their ironic inscription above King Jesus' crown of thorns. Soldiers and ordinary people jeered the royal title at him. Yet the throne of Jesus was the cross of Christ, from which he dispensed kingly mercy and justice toward the humble criminal who shared his execution. Writing to the Colossians, Saint Paul describes the truth about Jesus and his kingship, using words like fullness, peace, and forgiveness. So let us go rejoicing!

## ST. CECILIA—NOVEMBER 22

Although Cecilia is one of the most famous of the Roman martyrs, the familiar stories about her are apparently not founded on authentic material. There is no trace of honor being paid her in early times. A fragmentary inscription of the late fourth century refers to a church named after her, and her feast was celebrated at least in 545. According to legend, Cecilia was a young Christian of high rank betrothed to a Roman named Valerian. Through her influence, Valerian was converted, and was martyred along with his brother. The legend about Cecilia's death says that after being struck three times on the neck with a sword, she lived for three days, and asked the pope to convert her home into a church. Since the time of the Renaissance she has usually been portrayed with a viola or a small organ.

### **EL TRONO DE LA CRUZ**

Hoy concluimos el año litúrgico con la solemnidad de Cristo Rey. A primera vista, podríamos preguntarnos qué tiene que ver esto con nuestras vidas. ¿Qué importancia tiene que Cristo sea Rey? ¿Necesitamos un rey? Si somos sinceros con nosotros mismos, debemos admitir que sí necesitamos a alguien a quien seguir, un rey que gobierne nuestros corazones, mentes y vidas con bondad. Abandonados a nuestra suerte, siguiendo nuestras propias tendencias, estamos condenados a no cumplir la gran llamada de Dios a crecer y vivir en santidad. Cristo nos pastoreará, no desde una posición de poder o de autoridad, aunque ambas cosas también son suyas, sino desde el trono de la cruz, el trono de la humildad, la compasión y la paz.

### **JESÚS, LA IMAGEN DEL DIOS INVISIBLE**

Parte del desafío de vivir como hijo de Dios es no poder ver a Dios, saber cómo es Dios. Cuando nos preguntamos cómo es Dios, qué desea o cómo actúa, sólo tenemos que mirar a Cristo, que derrama su vida en el amor compasivo de Dios.

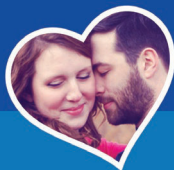


