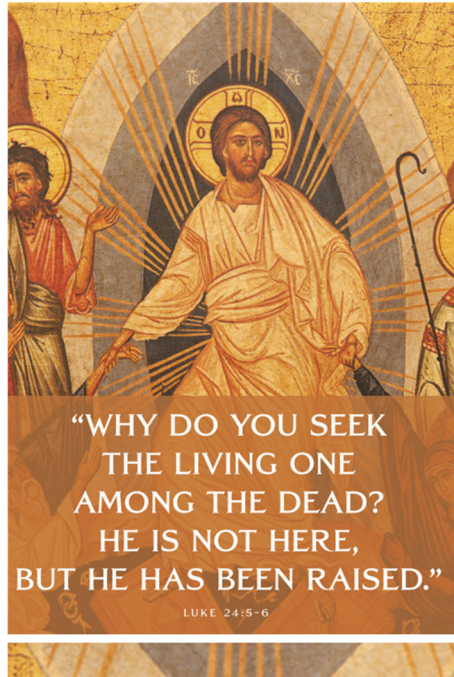

GOD'S OVERFLOWING KINDNESS

The superabundance of God's kindness ties all of today's readings together. Especially when life overwhelms us, the Lord provides all we need, and then some.

In the Acts of the Apostles, Peter takes the lead when facing the Sanhedrin. We might expect the man who denied Jesus to crumble under the imposing glare of the high priest. Instead, the Holy Spirit helps him testify to his faith in Jesus Christ. What Peter had lacked before, courage and conviction, God provides in abundance.

Similarly, today's Gospel shows Jesus providing a surplus of fish for the disciples. They have no luck fishing until the Lord intercedes. Jesus supplies an almost ridiculous number of fish, and he cooks it for them, too.

As our reading from Revelation affirms, the overflowing riches of God require constant praise. Countless creatures—"everything in the universe"—cry out to honor the Lord, forever and ever.

THIRD SUNDAY OF EASTER

CRY OUT WITH JOY TO GOD, ALL THE EARTH; O SING TO THE GLORY OF HIS NAME, O RENDER HIM GLORIOUS PRAISE, ALLELUIA.

PSALM 66:1-2

Jesus appears to seven of his disciples, among them Peter who proclaims his unflinching love for the Lord. Jesus commissions him to feed the sheep (3). Later, in the face of persecution, Peter and the apostles proclaim the name of Jesus (1), the Lamb who was slain (2) and who rescues us from death (Ps).

God exalted Jesus as leader and savior.

When the disciples came ashore,

"SMOTING" OR NON-"SMOTING"?

Some times I get angry at things that frustrate me. So I have to struggle with the line in our first reading, where the disciples were "rejoicing that they had been found worthy to suffer dishonor for the sake of the name" (Acts 5:41).

Imagine rejoicing over pain and suffering. These disciples had seen Jesus on the cross. When he rose from the dead, they began to see that his suffering was not a tragic loss, but a sign of his glory. And when they suffered because they believed in him, as in today's reading, they saw that as a way to imitate Jesus on the cross. Those who had followed him in life could also follow him to the cross.

Most of us today find ourselves suffering because we have done wrong. God does not use special interventions to smite sinners. Think of the times we were punished as a child. Think of the times we lost a friend because of a cruel remark. These are the result of our actions. These are sufferings that we would rather avoid.

Jesus, however, suffered for our sins when he was totally innocent. If he could do that, could we not accept suffering for our own sins when it comes? If we behave differently because of it, if we can grow to be better persons, then that suffering can be our way of accepting the cross.

Of course, not all suffering is caused by the sins of the person suffering. The suffering of the innocent is a great mystery, a cause for sorrow and a challenge to help where we can. But like growing pains, all suffering is a step to new life in Christ. And that is what Easter is about.

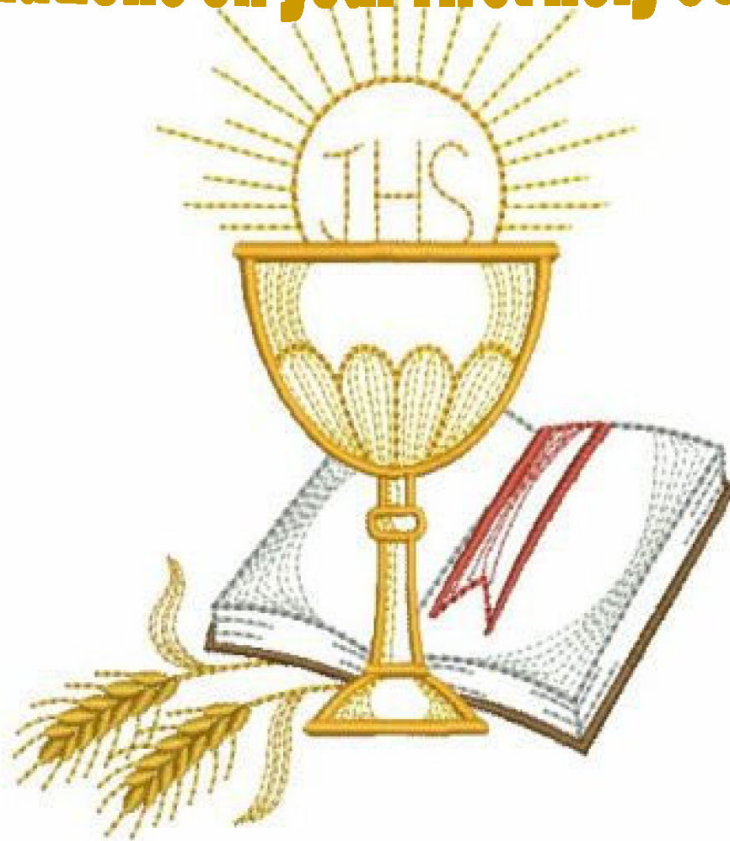

Our History, Our Future—Our Altar

One item that has not been sponsored yet is our altar.

In 1968, our altar made of Bianco Carrara marble arrived from Italy and was installed in the then newly-built church on the corner of Lafayette and Walnut streets. When we moved from our Lafayette Street location to Starr Drive, our altar moved with us to its temporary home in our current Chapel Center. One more move is in our altar's future. When our new church is finished, its journey to its permanent home will be complete.

Other rededication items still available are our tabernacle, altar candles, sancto light, and processional cross. Additional memorial items not yet sponsored include the sound system, porte-cochere (entrance covering), pews and kneelers, holy water fonts, nave chandelier lights, and disabled parking spaces.

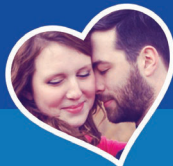

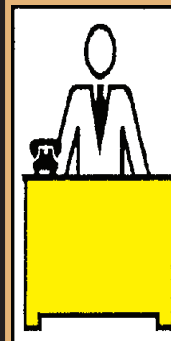

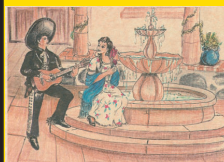
