THE EXALTATION OF THE HOLY CROSS-SEPTEMBER 14

On September 14, the Church celebrates the Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross. The feast commemorates the finding of the relic of the True Cross by St. Helena in 326 and the dedication of the Church of the Holy Sepulchre by her son, Constantine, in 335.

Bishop Anthony Taylor said on his homily of June 29, 2021 at St. Andrew's Cathedral: "We preach the "exaltation" of the cross of Jesus not to exalt suffering in itself, but rather because it is our greatest proof of just how completely God loves us. This cross points to a God who participates in human suffering as a fellow sufferer."

OUR LADY OF SORROWS-SEPTEMBER 15

Mary is venerated under this title to commemorate the seven sorrows that she suffered: The prophecy of Simeon, the flight into Egypt, the loss of the child Jesus in the temple, meeting Jesus carrying his cross, the Crucifixion, receiving the body of Jesus from the cross, and the burial of Jesus. A devotional image of her shows her heart pierced with seven swords to represent these sorrows.
