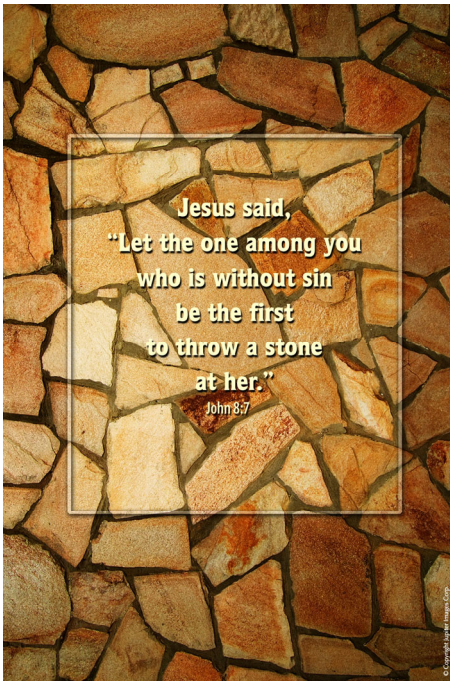

# FIFTH SUNDAY OF LENT

GIVE ME JUSTICE, O GOD, AND PLEAD MY CAUSE AGAINST A NATION THAT IS FAITHLESS. FROM THE DECEITFUL AND CUNNING RESCUE ME, FOR YOU, O GOD, ARE MY STRENGTH.

PSALM 43:1-2

To the exiles in Babylon, Isaiah foretells a new exodus (1), when the Lord will lead his people from captivity to freedom (Ps). True freedom is rooted in the person of Jesus, not in observance of the Law (2). It is he who challenges us to examine our own hearts before self-righteously judging others (3).

FIRST READING—ISAIAH 43:16-21

See, I am doing something new!

PSALM—PSALM 126

The Lord has done great things for us; we are filled with joy.

SECOND READING—PHILIPPIANS 3:8-14

I have been taken possession of by Christ Jesus.

GOSPEL—JOHN 8:1-11

Go, and from now on do not sin any more.

## GOD'S JUSTICE

The story of Jesus and the woman caught in adultery is sometimes considered as a put-down of the scribes and Pharisees. They were hoping to get Jesus to cause a scandal by refuting the law, or, if he upheld the law, the woman would be killed with Jesus' approval. Jesus had a better idea. He shows that God's justice is mercy and forgiveness. He also knew that someone whose sins were forgiven would be willing to forgive the woman.

That's what St. Paul means in the second reading. He says he has given up the idea of making himself righteous (right with God) by keeping the laws of his people. Now he depends on his faith in Christ and Christ's forgiveness, which was shown in his death and resurrection. Why did Paul come to this kind of faith? Because he had been forgiven for persecuting Christians. He had persecuted them, not because he was evil, but because he thought he was keeping the law.

So is keeping the law a bad thing? No, but the important thing is why we keep the law. We can do it like the Pharisees—keeping the law as a status symbol: "I'm too good (or too important) to break the law." Or we can choose to follow Jesus' way of love. Then we still keep the laws and commandments, only because they are examples of how to love God and love each other.

## Stepping Stones

### “Honoring Our Past, Building Our Future” Progress Update

Keep track of our permanent free-standing church construction progress right here!  
We will post updates and milestones monthly in our Stepping Stones column,  
so that you are always up to date on the progress!

#### Design Work Progress

The schematic design phase is continuing with our construction team (Michael G. Imber Architects, Core Architects, Nabholz Construction, civil and structural engineers, and representatives from our St. Joseph Design Subcommittee). At a recent meeting, the architects presented the 30% review of the Schematic Design (SD) for our Church. The overall purpose of the 30% review is to define the major elements of the project’s design and refine the project’s scope, schedule and budget. We reviewed the basic architectural floor plan and elevations, asked questions, and gave feedback. Overall, the 30% design phase is the foundation upon which design of our new church will sit. Taking the time to analyze the drawings and give feedback will pay off as the design work continues.

Our 50% SD review will be towards the end of April. These reviews will keep us on track for better pricing to meet our budget, while confirming that the submitted plans and specifications will meet our objectives of the project without significant changes.

#### Other Subcommittee News

Three of our subcommittees will meet at the end of this month.

**Liturgical Arts and Interiors Subcommittee** will develop guidelines and criteria to ensure that art work in our new church will complement the classical design of our new church and inspire us to raise our minds and hearts to God.

**Landscaping and Grounds Subcommittee** will review the City of Fayetteville’s Landscape Requirements Ordinance and begin to plan a beautiful and spiritual space around our new church.

## FIFTH SUNDAY OF LENT

### An Age-Old Story of Judgment

In our Gospel today we hear an ancient story, but one that feels like it could be taken out of the headlines today. We can be very quick to pass judgment on others, those with different political or cultural backgrounds, or perhaps with a different sexual orientation. Jesus was teaching in the temple, and the scribes and Pharisees did not like the message that he was proclaiming or the popularity he was gaining. When a nearby woman was caught in adultery, they thought it was the perfect chance to trip Jesus up, wondering how he would respond when the Mosaic Law provided clear consequences for such behavior. Many would be able to quote instantly chapter and verse of the law pertaining to the infraction. Instead of answering their question, Jesus turned it back on the accusers: "Let the one among you who is without sin be the first to throw a stone at her."

### Drawing in the Sand

Awaiting the response of those challenging him, Jesus bent over and wrote in the sand. According to scripture scholar John Pilch, this was a simple technique that peasants used to buy time in a discussion or argument. Instead of looking the scribes and pharisees in the eye, he looked down and did his own thing while they all slipped away. The scriptures do not tell us what the woman was doing during this time. But by not looking at her, Jesus gave her a chance to restore her own dignity. He didn't comment on her innocence or guilt. Rather, he instructed her to go forth and sin no more. It is not our past that matters as much as the choices we make now and in the future. Again and again, God gives us the chance to start our life over. This is our challenge this Lent, to continue to use the opportunities we are given to repent and grow.

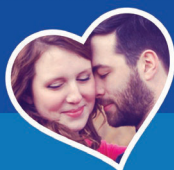

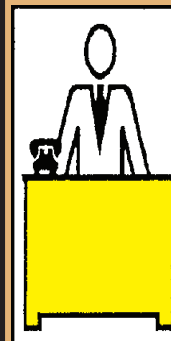

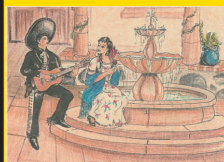
