## ETERNAL LIFE

What happens after we die? Most religions and philosophies provide some notion of this, but we are confounded by the mystery of it all. Today's readings give us a glimpse through the faith of martyrs and in the words of Jesus. In the Old Testament reading, the Maccabee brothers assert with total confidence that the God who gave them life would also raise them to eternal life. This was not universally accepted in ancient Israel. The Sadducees, who denied any resurrection of the dead, try to trap Jesus with a hypothetical riddle. Jesus, known for turning such things around, dismisses their unbelief, noting that even Moses knew that all are alive in God. Saint Paul tells the Thessalonians that we live in everlasting encouragement and hope, and Psalm 17 echoes this with words of faith that we will see God's face, waking in God's loving presence.

## DEDICATION OF ST. JOHN LATERAN—NOVEMBER 9

The feast of the Dedication of the Basilica of St. John Lateran is celebrated by the entire Church. It marks the dedication of the cathedral church of Rome by Pope Sylvester I in 324. This church is the cathedra (or chair) of the bishop of Rome, who is the Pope. A Latin inscription in the Church reads: "omnium ecclesiarum Urbis et Orbis mater et caput." Translated, this means, "The mother and head of all churches of the city and of the world." The basilica was originally named the Archbasilica of the Most Holy Savior. However, it is called St. John Lateran because it was built on property donated to the Church by the Laterani family, and because the monks from the monastery of St. John the Baptist and St. John the Divine served it.

## “Honoring Our Past, Building Our Future” Progress Update

Keep track of our permanent free-standing church construction progress right here in our Stepping Stones column.

## Groundbreaking for our new church in 2023

We have moved from the “schematic design” portion of the design process to the “design development” phase. By the end of this phase, the design drawings and specifications will be sufficiently complete to establish and define the configuration, spaces, principal structures and systems for our church. This information will help finalize the project budget and timeline. **Updated drawings of our new church will be presented on Tuesday, November 8, at 7 pm in the cafeteria. Everyone is invited. Light refreshments will be served.**

Building material shortages and supply chain issues have persisted well into 2022, impacting construction costs and timelines. These factors have helped us to better refine which elements we will be able to include in phase I and which will be included or embellished at a later date or building phase.

In our early planning stages, we prioritized elements that could be partially built in phase one and embellished later. When we exceeded our campaign fundraising goal of \$5.5 million, we included the completed spire (steeple) and a nursery/multipurpose room. Unfortunately with higher construction costs, the base of the spire can be built in phase I and completed in later phases and the nursery/multipurpose will have to be added at a later date or phase.

**Although we have made design element adjustments due to construction cost pressures beyond our control, we continue to look for ways to restore design elements in Phase 1. If costs come in lower than expected or if sufficient additional campaign pledges are made, we may be able to restore some design elements.**

We expect to break ground in the Summer of 2023. This is a little later than we had previously projected, but the extra design time has proven necessary in order to ensure that we use your sacrificial gifts well in a challenging market and still deliver a beautiful building that will serve our parish for generations to come.

Thank you to everyone that has made a pledge or is donating to the building fund collections. **Your generosity allows us to stay on course in building the kind of timeless, Christ-centered church which parishioners desire. Also unchanged is our target seating capacity of 650+ in phase one, with the ability to expand to a seating capacity over 1,000 in later phases.**
